D.M. Nachane is a Senior Professor at the Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research. Professor Nachane has a Ph.D in Economics from Bombay University. His thesis was on the 'Studies in the Theory of Optimal Economic Growth'.

He has been a lecturer (1971 – 1973), a reader (1976 – 1978), Professor of Quantitative Economics (1978 – 2003) and Director (1 April 1993 to 31 March 1999) at the Department of Economics, University of Mumbai; and an Assistant Professor at the National Institute of Bank Management, India (1973 – 1976).

He has held many foreign appointments. Most recently, he has been a Visiting Professor at the Otto von Guericke University, Magdeurg, Germany (Winter 2002, Summer 2003 and Summer 2004) and a Jean Monnet Fellow at the European University Institute, Italy (1 March – 16 June 2001).

Professor Nachane has also been a member of many official bodies and held honorary appointments. Several of these appointments include being a Member, Technical Advisory Committee on Monetary Policy, Reserve Bank of India (2005 onwards); Member, Board of Directors, Deposit Insure & Credit Guarantee Corporation (October 2005 onwards); Member, Board of Directors, SBI-DFHI (October 2004 onwards); and Member, Research Advisory Committee, Clearing Corporation of India Ltd (2004 onwards).

He has also held many appointments in academic bodies. These include being a Member, Governing Board, National Institute of Bank Management, Pune (2005 onwards); President of the Indian Econometric Society (2002 – 2003); Member, Governing Board, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai (1993 – 1998 and 2001 – 2003); and Elected Member of the Academy of Sciences, New York, United States of America.

Professor Nachane has written six books and 85 journal articles. He has also received many awards and distinctions. He has also supervised 20 Ph.D and 10 M.Phil theses.
