Professor Hasan Askari Rizvi is independent Political and Defence Consultant. He obtained M.A. and PhD. in International Relations/Political Science from the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia, USA, and M. Phil in Politics from Leeds University, Leeds, UK. He did his post-doctoral work at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign (1982-83), and was a Visiting Scholar at the Co-operative Monitoring Center, Sandia National Labs, Albuquerque, NM (2002).

He held Pakistan Chairs at the School of International & Public Affairs (SIPA), Columbia University, New York, USA (January 1996 - July 1999), and South Asia Institute, Heidelberg University, Germany (February 1988 – January 1991). He was also Professor (1990-2001) and Chairman, Department of Political Science, Punjab University (1991-1995), but left this job in 2001 to become an independent researcher.

His research papers have been published in professional journals in Pakistan and abroad and his political commentaries appear in the leading national dailies of Pakistan. He has also published several monographs on South Asian political and security affairs.

His books include *Military, State and Society in Pakistan* (New York: St. Martin's Press, and Macmillan Press, London, 2000), *Pakistan and the Geostrategic Environment* (London: Macmillan Press, 1993), *The Military and Politics in Pakistan* (Lahore, 1974, 1976, 1986, 2000) and *Internal Strife and External Intervention* (Lahore, 1981).
