Jayadeva Uyangoda is Professor and Head of Department, Department of Political Science and Public Policy at University of Colombo, Sri Lanka. His recent research has focussed on ethnic conflicts and peace processes in multi-ethnic societies, with special reference to Sri Lanka. He co-edited *Sri Lanka's Peace Process 2002: Critical Perspectives* (2003) and *Beyond Mediation and Negotiation: Towards Transformative Peace in Sri Lanka* (2004). He has been Senior Fulbright Fellow at the American University of Washington, DC in 1997, Arthur Andrew Distinguish Chair in Asian Studies at University of Hawaii in 2001 and British Academy Fellow at Edinburgh University in 2001.

Professor Uyangoda has worked closely with Sri Lankan governments in the areas of peace negotiations and constitutional reform. He has also been active in the civil society initiatives in Sri Lanka in the areas of peace-building, democracy and reconciliation. He is also the founder co-editor of the monthly journal, *polity*, published in Colombo.
