Zhang Jun is Professor of Economics at Fudan University and serves the Director for China Center for Economic Studies at Fudan University. He was educated in China, Britain and the United States respectively during 1981-1994. Since 1997, he has held visiting or lecturing fellowships at London School of Economics, Harvard University, Tokyo Metropolitan University and Kyungpook National University in Korea. He also teaches for EMBA programs at CEIBS and School of Business at Shanghai Jiaotong University.

Professor Zhang Jun is one of the leading economists in China, specialising in many areas of current economic development and growth in China. He has many publications both in Chinese and English, including papers published in *Journal of Asian Economics*, *Journal of Chinese Economics and Business Studies*, *East Asian Review*, etc. He is also a columnist, frequently writing for *Project Syndicate*, *Financial Times*, *Economic Observer*, etc.
