

Brij V. Lal

Brij V. Lal is a Professor of Pacific and Asian History in the Research School of Pacific and Asian Studies at the Australian National University, which he joined after teaching Pacific and World History at the Universities of the South Pacific, Papua New Guinea and Hawaii. He is the General Editor of the NUS-based in-progress 'Encyclopaedia of Indians Overseas'.

Professor Lal was a member of the three-person Fiji Constitution Review Commission whose report formed the basis of that country's multiracial 1997 constitution.

For his distinguished public service, he was appointed an Officer of the Order of Fiji, and for his scholarship he was elected a Fellow of the Australian Humanities Academy. His semi-autobiographical book, "Mr Tulsi's Store: A Fijian Journey" was chosen by the San Francisco-based Kiriama Prize as a Notable Book of 2002.
