Dr Kripa Sridharan is a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Political Science, National University of Singapore. She teaches International Relations and South Asian politics and foreign policy. She has won the University's Excellent Teacher Award in 2003 and 2004.

Her articles have appeared in Asian Studies Review, Third World Quarterly, Round Table, Diplomacy and Statecraft, and Asian Journal of Political Science. She has authored a book entitled "The ASEAN Region in India's Foreign Policy" (Dartmouth: UK and USA, 1996) and has co-edited "Human Rights Perspectives" (Singapore: UNAS, 1999).
