

## **M. G. Quibria**

Professor M. G. Quibria is an economist whose professional interests include issues in development, trade and Asian economies.

He is the author of more than 70 scholarly articles which have been published in leading economics and development journals such as Quarterly Journal of Economics, International Economic Review, Journal of Development Economics, Oxford Economic Papers, Canadian Journal of Economics, World Development, World Economy and Bulletin of Economic Research. He is also the author/editor of a dozen scholarly books published by reputed publishers. He has directed/co-directed a number of high-profile studies and publications at the Asian Development Bank (ADB) such as Emerging Asia, the commemorative volume on the 13<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of the ADB, and Asian Development outlook, the flagship annual publication of the ADB.

As part of the senior management of the ADB, Professor Quibria has held a number of senior directorial and advisory positions in recent years. Currently, he is Advisor to the newly-established independent Operations Evaluation Department.

Professor Quibria also held a number of teaching and research positions at Nuffield College, Oxford; Boston University; University of Dhaka; ADB Institute; and FASID-GRIPS graduate program in development studies in Tokyo.

He obtained his MA and PhD degrees in economics from Princeton University.
