

## **Shapan Adnan**

Assoc Professor Shapan Adnan was educated at the Universities of Sussex and Cambridge, and undertook research at the University of Oxford. He has taught at the Universities of Dhaka and Chittagong, and currently teaches in the South Asian Studies Programme of the National University of Singapore.

His research interests are in the fields of political economy, sociology and anthropology, and include agrarian structure and capitalist transformation, peasant politics and social organisation, development and the environment, critique of the 'development business' and flood control programmes, as well as socio-demographic issues related to fertility and migration.

Assoc Professor Adnan's published books include a fieldwork-based study of indigenous peoples and ethnic domination entitled "Migration, Land Alienation and Ethnic Conflict: Causes of Poverty in the Chittagong Hill Tracts of Bangladesh".
