

## **Sumit K. Majumdar**

Sumit K. Majumdar is a Professor of Technology Strategy at the University of Texas at Dallas.

As an academic, Professor Majumdar's current research interests are in telecommunications sector policy, on issues of ownership and property rights, productivity of firms, strategies and the performance of firms in Indian Industry and technology strategy. He has an extensive research profile in these fields, dealing with issues that arise in the Indian context as well as for the United States, and has widely published in the most significant journals in the field. Previously, he was a professor of Strategic Management at the Imperial College, University of London, and a member of the faculty in the Corporate Strategy area at the School of Business of the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor.

Professor Majumdar holds a PhD from the University of Minnesota. Prior to entering the academia, he qualified as a Chartered Accountant in London, where he worked for a number of years as a professional accountant and auditor.

He has consulted professionally for a number of global corporations on issues relating to corporate and technology strategy and advised government agencies on several aspects of telecommunications regulation.

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
